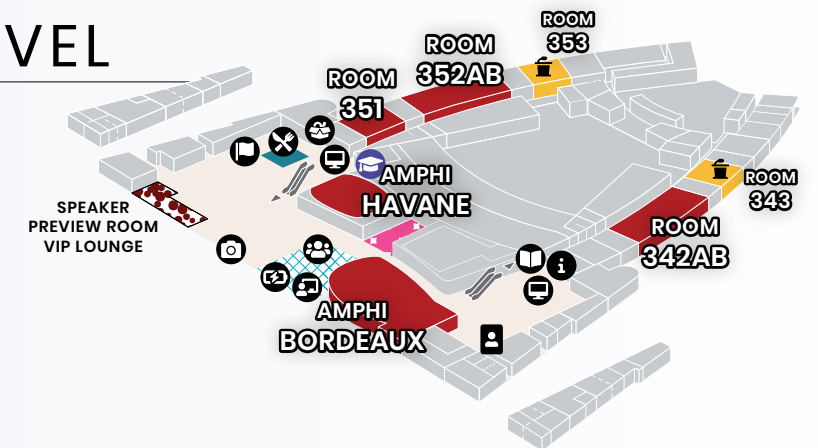
CIRCULATION MAP

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

WE'LL EXPLAIN HOW IT WORKS!

In an effort to adhere to our mission of providing objective medical sessions, while accommodating an ever-increasing body of attendees, IMCAS works diligently to maintain a strict distinction between the scientific and commercial content. The IMCAS scientific program is largely divided into non-sponsored and sponsored sessions.

SCIENTIFIC SESSIONS (NON-SPONSORED)

These scientific sessions provide learning that is entirely based on medical research. The contents of non-sponsored sessions are built by the IMCAS Scientific Committee and any partnering academic societies, both ensuring that there are no biases or influences from commercial bodies. These sessions are eligible for CME accreditation.

SCIENTIFIC SESSIONS UNDER AN UNRESTRICTED EDUCATIONAL GRANT (NON-SPONSORED)

Companies may get involved in the program through educational grants, yet these sessions remain under the category of non-sponsored because an educational grant is a financial donation with no exchange partnership at stake. The scientific content of a granted session is also developed entirely by the IMCAS Scientific Committee and is therefore eligible for CME accreditation.



SPONSORED SESSIONS

These sessions are commercial programs that promote a product or activity of the sponsoring company, and it is the organizing company, not the IMCAS Scientific Board, who manages these sessions. The contents of sponsored sessions are not endorsed by IMCAS and are ineligible for any CME accreditation.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST (COI) POLICY

All the above breaks down the IMCAS Conflict of Interest Policy.

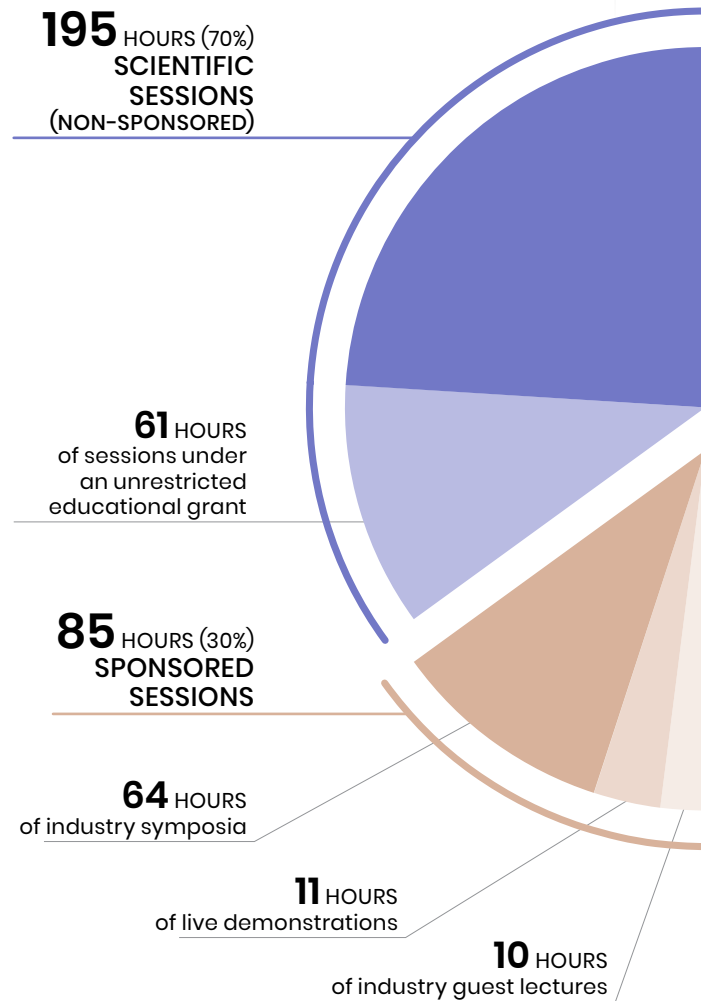
Before a lecture, IMCAS speakers are required to disclose any and all potentially distorting influences that may be seen as a conflict of interest (COI). A COI is a situation in which a person who is lecturing at an IMCAS congress has a sufficient personal or financial relationships with a commercial or non-commercial entity that may influence the content of his or her presentation.
